



T11S Stereo Bluetooth Headset User's Guide

Charging the Headset:

- ✓ Please charge fully before using the headset
- ✓ Plug the charger one end into any PC's USB port, the other round end into the little hole of the headset, and you should see the blue/red light flash once or twice
- ✓ Then the red light will stay on, when it's off, it means your headset is fully charged, this may take 2-3 hours
- ✓ After the headset is fully charged, it's ready for use
- ✓ Turning on/off the headset: Turn on the headset, by pressing firm the button (as shown on the picture), until you see the blue/red light blinks on the big black clip. You may turn it off by pressing the button until all light is gone.

Using the headset with your mobile phone, PDA, laptop etc:

1. Turn on the bluetooth in your other bluetooth device, and make it "visible" to other bluetooth devices (refer to your mobile/PC user manual)
 2. Press the on/off button on the headset, **HOLD THE BUTTON LONG ENOUGH TO SEE the red/blue light blinking** – this is the only time the headset may be found by the phone! You may not pair the headset with only blue light blinking, or no light at all.
 3. From your phone/PC etc search bluetooth device, then select "connect", or "pair device" – *Please turn off the "auto pairing" function if your phone has it, as it will tell you "paired" when it's not; and use "manual pairing" instead.*
 4. You will be asked for a password to pair them, input "0000", "Enter" or "OK", and you phone will show "connected" to T11S in a second, and the earphone icon would be on usually on your phone's main screen. If you have plug the headset into your ear, you should hear a "beep" and some noise too
 5. After the headset is connected, please insert it your ears (the short one is left, long one is right) – remember to plug the in ear earphone's 3.5 mm into the hole or you will hear nothing.
 6. You may disconnect the headset any time by selecting "disconnect" from your phone/PC, etc, the headset will turn itself off after a while, or you may turn it off right after disconnection
 7. Volume control: there is a "+" and "-" button on the big black clip, press "+" to make it louder, and "-" to make it quieter. The micro phone can certainly work with mobile phones, but depending on your PC's settings, you may or may not use the microphone for MSN, Skype etc
- Please note: The instructions here may only be used for information only, the actual installation might not happen exactly as instructed, due to the product development, and various settings of PCs, and the software versions etc.
 - Compatible with: ALL mobile phones PC PDA etc that have bluetooth
 - For the nice high quality stereo sound, you can only hear it when your other bluetooth device (phone/PDA/PC etc) may produce it via bluetooth!
